Awards

Up to four awards totalling \$2,000 may be presented to post-secondary students studying at an accredited Canadian institution. Each eligible student must be a card-carrying member of NASA or the dependent of a card-carrying member of NASA with a minimum membership of one year. *Note - University of Alberta employees using the tuition fee remittance under Article 24 (Operating) and Article 14 (Trust) of the Collective Agreement are excluded from applying.*

Essays

Along with this application, include a 500 word essay:

In keeping with our 40th anniversary, this year's essay question will focus on NASA contributions to the membership. Describe three instances that NASA has improved staff conditions over the past 40 years. Please provide specific examples.

Papers should be approximately 2 pages double-spaced. ***Do not put your name on your paper***, but be sure that the paper is properly attached to this application document. The essay will be judged based on the demonstrated understanding of the topic, the points raised in the argument, as well as proper grammar, spelling and formatting. Papers will be adjudicated by the NASA Award Committee.

Deadline

Confirmation of completed enrollment in the current academic year must be submitted with this application. The application and essay are due on **July 3, 2018**. Candidates will be notified of the award results by the end of July.
